

## Survey of bird communities, 2025

The bird population survey must be conducted at the following points by the different groups, in the order given below, to avoid disturbing each other (the name of the forest plot is indicated in parentheses on the attached map:

1st. group: G6, G3, G4, G5, F6, F5, F1, F2


2nd group: F6, F5, F1, F2, G6, G3, G4, G5

The protocol must include the date, group number, and the names of the group members.

Tasks to be performed upon arrival at each designated point:

- Record the point number in the protocol.
- Note the start time of the observation (hour:minute).
- During the 5-minute survey, record all bird species seen or heard within a 50-meter radius of the point, inside the boundaries of the designated forest plot, along with the number of individuals.
- Record the number of bird individuals that could not be identified by species.
- Note the departure time from the point (hour:minute).
- Record any events during the count that may have influenced the number of birds seen or heard.

The map of the forest to be surveyed is provided. The numbers indicate the survey points.
